

Will elderly Malaysians enjoy sustainable, affordable and quality aged care services?

Against this background, a survey conducted by Care Matters in 2014 indicated the possible costs involved for the facilities/services offered by nursing homes/care centres within the Klang Valley.

How much is it?

The charges listed include only the room, laundry, personal care and meals, and excludes milk formula for tube feeding. There are extra charges for medication, clinical services and therapy visits. The charges also vary depending on the resident's clinical needs and the family's choice of doctors and therapists. Most of the time, the operator will provide these allied health services based on family's instructions.
